2 to 3 - nominated by the province

Written Exam	Practice Judge	Evaluation
80 %	at Qualification meet, Espoir or Canadian Open 1 complete figures event plus a minimum of 7 routine events - prelims & finals	Figures: satisfactory or better Routines: 65 % overall with the majority of events 60 % or better

3 - recertification

Written Exam	Judge	Evaluation Goals
80 % when required, as determined by the SCOT certification leader	at Qualification meet or Espoir 1 or more figure events plus routine events as assigned by the SCOT panels leader	Figures: 65% - 70 % Routines: 65% - 70 % overall with the majority of events 65 % or better

3 to 4 - as approved or nominated by SCOT leaders of certification and evaluation

Written Exam	Judge	Evaluation
90 %	at Qualification meet, Espoir or Canadian Open 1 or more figure events plus routine events as assigned by the SCOT panels leader	Figures: 75 % Routines: 75 % overall with the majority of events 70 % or better

4 - recertification

Written Exam	Judge	Evaluation Goals
90 % when required, as determined by the SCOT certification leader	at Qualification meet, Espoir or Canadian Open 1 or more figure events plus routine events as assigned by the SCOT panels leader	Figures: 75% - 80 % Routines: 75% - 80 % overall with the majority of events 75 % or better

DOWNGRADING could occur for one of the following reasons:

- A) written exam is not passed after the second attempt
- B) two or more consecutive years having extremely weak evaluations, as determined by the SCOT evaluations leader
- C) inactivity during three or more consecutive years
